Special Guests

Todd Stewardson – City of Abbotsford Parks Manager **Steve Coleman** – President, Sport Abbotsford

Todd Stewardson:

- Provided an update on the Sport Field & Sport Court Strategy, targeted for implementation by 2027.
- Discussed understanding community growth and field investment priorities.
- Shared that funding is allocated for the next five years to support the plan.
- Mentioned upcoming plans for King Road and McKenzie sites (pending Agricultural Land Commission approval).
- Noted work being done to standardize field maintenance practices.

Steve Coleman:

- Explained Sport Abbotsford's structure and purpose, operating under three pillars:
 - 1. **Advocacy** Representing the needs of local sports organizations.
 - 2. **Communication** Facilitating collaboration among sports groups (baseball, softball, slo-pitch, etc.), as well as with the City and School District.
 - 3. **Education** Supporting development opportunities for local organizations.
- Sport Abbotsford is a non-profit organization that brings groups together to identify and address common challenges.

Treasurer's Report (Stephanie Deglan)

- Gaming grant update and preparation of financials for AGM.
- Budget remains on track; all payments are current.
- Sufficient funds available to upgrade aging equipment, including umpire gear, catching gear, tents, and signage.
- A scholarship fund has been added to next year's budget, which remains similar to last year's overall budget.

Secretary's Report (Stephanie Ingwersen)

• Preparing AGM documents and supporting the transition to a new Secretary following the AGM.

Vice President & Director Reports

VP1 – Chelsey Iwama

- Preparing AGM report and assisting with transition for incoming VP1.
- Reviewed Feedback Form results: only 7% response rate; majority feedback was positive toward coaches.

- 60.5% of respondents indicated they had not contacted commissioners.
- Higher number of ejections this year need to emphasize education and mentorship.
- Suggested pairing experienced coaches with new ones and possibly inviting a BC Umpire Association guest speaker for the coaches' banquet.
- Volunteer points system will apply to the summer season only (to be revisited in spring).
- Responsible for registering teams for tournaments and booking hotels; will help onboard new VP1 into these duties.

VP2 – Brad Nedimovich (Report by Email)

- Preparing AGM report.
- 15U single-season tryouts completed; 15U AAA coach selected (Derek Giesbrecht).
- 15U AAA team announcement: October 25. 15U AA coach and team selection to follow.
